In addition, the following information is given to residents describing the smoke testing process via flyers which are distributed 1-3 weeks prior to smoke testing:

## Clayton County Water Authority



Clayton County Water Authority, with support of various engineers and contractors, is rehabilitating the **SEWER** collection system in your area. To facilitate this work, **SMOKE TESTING** of the collection system will be done to look for leaks. **Smoke that you may see is non-toxic, creates no fire hazard, and will not harm children, pets, or plants.** Persons with severe asthma should avoid breathing any smoke to avoid irritation. Please help us notify shut-ins in your area that may not receive this notice. If smoke enters your house, you should report it to the crews conducting the test so we can help you locate the source while the test is still in progress. Repairs to your internal plumbing are at your own discretion, we are only testing for problems on the sewer mains outside.

Under normal circumstances, the smoke will not enter your home if the plumbing is working properly. You will see smoke coming from vents on the roof of your home, which is a normal occurrence. **In most cases, entrance of smoke in a dwelling is through fixtures that are not routinely used; therefore, we would request that you run water at all of your fixtures to ensure that all of the drain traps are full of water.** Please fill the traps immediately upon receiving this notice with approximately one quart of water. The testing will occur within the next few days so that the water will not have time to evaporate before we have completed our work. **It is not necessary that you be home during these tests. If smoke gets in while you are out, it will dissipate without leaving any odors. The smoke used is manufactured specifically for this application and is, therefore, non-toxic and non-staining.**
