**The Lovejoy Municipal Court has announced September 2023 Amnesty Month.**

This is a time to settle outstanding violations with the court and reduce arrests. It is to encourage individuals to resolve their cases from years 2010 - 2020. If you received a traffic ticket from a Lovejoy Police officer, you can look up your citation, and court date and pay online at [www.ticketfastpay.com](http://www.ticketfastpay.com) if it is not a must appear offense.

The Amnesty Program is for people with outstanding fines who FAILED TO APPEAR in court.

The Amnesty Program will allow the city to recall warrants in lieu of payment of fines. However, if a defendant cannot pay the cost of the citation, they will be allowed to post the failure to appear fee and sign for a new court date to have the case placed back on the court calendar. If the case is a mandatory court appearance, the defendant will be allowed to pay the fine, the warrant will be recalled and defendant must sign for a new court date to have the case placed back on the court calendar.

The offer of amnesty does not extend to probation warrants.

People with outstanding fines and warrants for traffic violations can pay at the Lovejoy Municipal Court at 2296 Talmadge Rd., Lovejoy, GA 30250, on Monday, Wednesday or Friday between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. (Tuesday is reserved for court sessions only). Inquiries, please call (678) 610-9748
